One of the main wood surface-carving designs in Whanganui is patiki (flounder One of the main surface-carving designs in Whanganui is patiki (flounder or flatfish). In the context of woodcarving, it is the diamond shaped notches that resemble the flounder's shape. The associative meanings with the patiki design are abundance & hospitality (the ability to provide for your iwi, hapu, whanau). and is the same for the kowhaiwhai (painted rafter) version (see image) & the woven tukutuku panel design.

Carver/artist Dominic Patea asserts that the patiki design has connotative meanings to the idea of 'returning home' linked to observations of the patiki's behaviour - if it dashes off, it usually returns to the same resting place in the silt of the river. That is perhaps another way to interpret that design- a sense of pride for Whanganui & knowing that this is our home always.




